A LETTER FROM VIVIDH SIDDHA

President of Thread Group

The second half of 2025 has been tremendously productive for the Thread ecosystem. We entered Q3 with strong momentum, and by the end of Q4, that trajectory only accelerated. Across specifications, tooling, membership, and market presence, our community made meaningful strides that position us exceptionally well for 2026.

On the technical front, the next iteration of the Thread specification continued moving toward finalization. This cycle's refinements—simplified large-scale commissioning, smarter routing in dense network environments, and enhanced diagnostics—have been guided by real-world product teams and deployment learnings. In parallel, we began sketching the early architecture for the subsequent version of the Thread specification. While still exploratory, the direction is clear: support for ultra-dense meshes, more advanced security primitives, and capabilities that better serve commercial buildings and next-generation IoT environments.

Developer and certification experiences also improved noticeably in the second half of the year. Faster reviews, more automation in our test harnesses, and expanded interoperability testing made it easier for companies to bring Thread-based products to market without friction. Many members reported shaving weeks off integration cycles—exactly the kind of efficiency we aim to deliver.

Ecosystem growth remained strong. Thread Group acquired over 30 new members from both established tech brands and emerging innovators across consumer, commercial, and industrial sectors, making our total membership base 240 members. Certified product volume continued to rise, reaching a milestone of over 1,100 products, and the visibility of Thread Border Routers and Matter-over-Thread devices improved significantly in retail and partner channels. Our presence at major events, along with coordinated campaigns with ecosystem partners, helped elevate awareness and clarify Thread's role as the secure, low-power foundation for interoperable IoT systems.

Regional meetups and working sessions throughout Q3 and Q4 were well attended, and our Fall 2025 Members Meeting in Stockholm was particularly energizing. The conversations around commissioning, diagnostics, and commercial deployments showed just how aligned our ecosystem has become on what the next phase of growth requires.

Looking ahead, 2026 is shaping up to be a pivotal year. We are on track to finalize Thread 1.5, deepen adoption in both consumer and commercial spaces, and continue our forward-looking work on what comes next. The foundation we built in 2025 gives us a clear path to accelerate.

To the entire Thread Group ecosystem, thank you for your contributions, collaboration, and commitment throughout this remarkable year. Wishing you all a very happy new year, and I look forward to carrying the momentum we've created in 2025 into an even more impactful 2026.
